The Richfield Town Board held a special meeting on September 3, 2020 at 7:00 pm at the Richfield Town Hall to discuss the needed repairs to the boiler. The meeting was opened at 7:00 pm by Supervisor Palevsky. Other board members in attendance were Bello and Frigault. Clerk Young was also in attendance.

The board received three estimates to repair/replace the boiler. Supervisor Palevsky asked the Town Attorney to review the estimates before a decision is made. The Attorney stated that because the bids are so drastically different, he could not comfortably advise the board. Supervisor Palevsky will submit an RFP to each of the contractors and ask them to re-submit their bids to the Clerk by September 21, 2020.

Motion by Frigault to hold a public hearing for the Charter Franchise Agreement Renewal on September 21, 2020 at 7:00 pm, second by Palevsky. All members were in favor.

Highway Superintendent Proctor would like to pave Ellard Rd, Buell Rd, and Yourno Rd. The estimated cost would be \$35,000.00. Chips would cover the cost of the additional paving.

Motion by Palevsky to authorize Highway Superintendent Proctor to pave Ellard Rd, Buell Rd, and Yourno Rd, at a cost of \$35,000.00, second by Frigault. Bello-yes, Frigault-yes, Palevsky-yes.

Dick Johnson asked the board if Highway Super Proctor could look into lowering a culvert pipe at Cross Rd and Rt 20.

Motion by Frigault to adjourn at 7:17 pm, second by Palevsky. All members were in favor.
